

2007-2008 Program Summary

- TOTAL SNOW COURSES MONITORED BY DWR: 265
- SNOW COURSES VISITED BY SNOW SURVEYS STAFF: 90
- SNOW COURSES KNOWN TO BE IN "GOOD" CONDITION: 68
- SNOW COURSES KNOWN TO NEED WORK: 41
- SNOW COURSES WITH CONDITIONS "UNKOWN": 156
- PROJECTED END OF MAINTENANCE WORK: NEVER!


